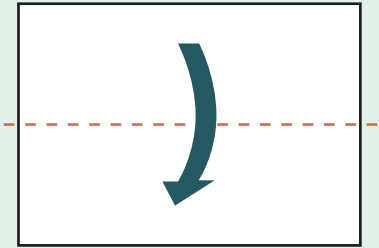


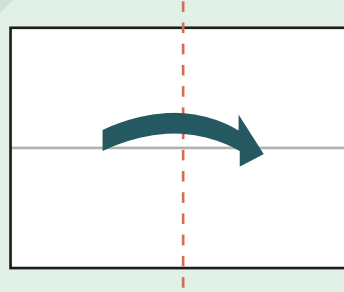
Paper owl: Make a glider from a sheet of A4!

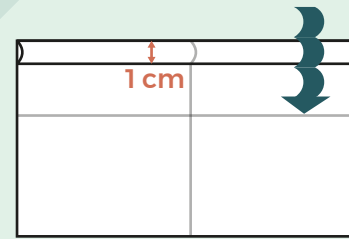
Take an A4 piece of paper and **fold and crease** across the **length**

2



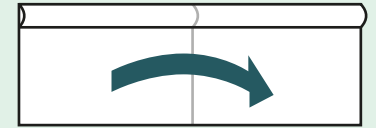
Fold and crease across the **width**

3



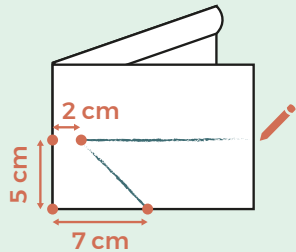
Fold and crease a 1 cm strip along the long edge. Keep folding the strip over until the centre crease

4



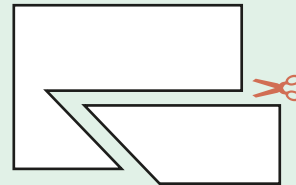
Fold in half along the existing crease

5



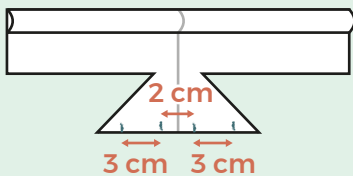
Measure and draw construction lines

6



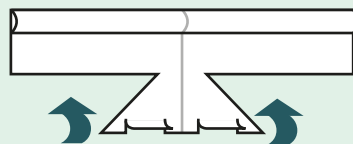
Hold the fold securely and **cut** along the drawn lines through **both layers** of paper

7



Unfold and flatten the paper. **Measure and draw** four **1 cm long** lines on the tail

8



Cut along the lines to create adjustable tabs. Carefully **bend** the tabs upards

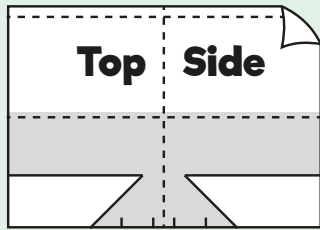

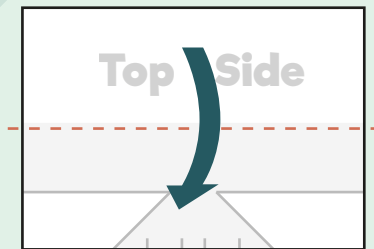
Paper owl: Print and make your owl glider!

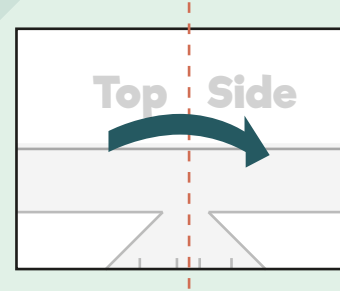
Print the double-sided owl template on A4.

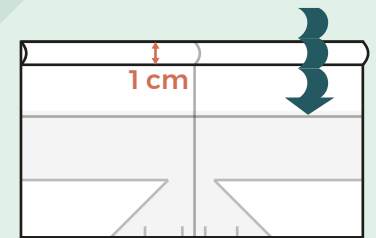
Fold and **crease** lengthways along the dashed line

3



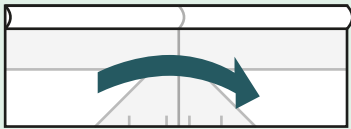
Fold and **crease** widthways along the dashed line

4



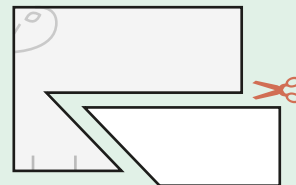
Fold and **crease** the dashed **1 cm strip**. Keep folding the strip over until the centre crease

5



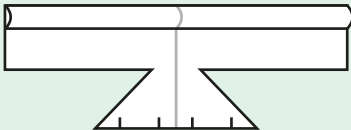
Fold in half along the existing crease

6



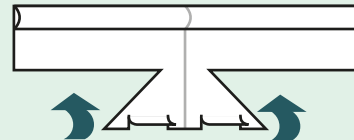
Hold the fold securely and **cut** along the lines through **both layers** of paper
